## **NOTICE OF HEARING**

WHEREAS the New Brunswick Insurance Board (the "Board") has this date issued an order calling for public hearings to review the 2010 rates and charges for private passenger automobile insurance as managed by Facility Association ("FA") in the Province of New Brunswick;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to provide an opportunity for FA and other interested persons who may be granted intervener standing, to address the Board concerning the 2010 rates and charges;

THEREFORE, THE BOARD HAS ORDERED THE FOLLOWING:

1 The Board shall hold a public hearing to review the 2010 rates and charges for private passenger automobile insurance as managed by FA in the Province of New Brunswick.

2 The public hearings contemplated by this Order shall be held in the City of Saint John, New Brunswick, as noted below, when and where the Board, FA and interveners may attend and make written and oral presentations.

3 Persons intending to intervene, must request intervener standing in writing by notifying the Board at the address below no later than January 29, 2010, and set out the name of the person or any authorized representative of the person and their mailing address, civic address, telephone and facsimile numbers and e-mail address, if applicable, and identify their language of choice. They must also establish their interest in the proceeding that justifies their possible intervener standing. Decisions of the Board in the matter of granting intervener status are final. Further, if an intervener intends to file written submissions with the Board, they must file a copy of their presentations with the Board no later than February 2, 2010.

4 Persons who do not wish to formally intervene but who wish to make written comments to the Board regarding the hearing must notify the Board, in writing, at the address below, no later than January 29, 2010 of their intent to file a letter of comment.
